



Victoria Methodist Church, Bristol is excited to be hosting another Advent Mystery Knitalong in 2025!

Over the course of Advent participants are invited to knit a small

neck scarf, (some of the testers found it also worked beautifully as a hair scarf!) which can be worn or given as a present on Christmas Day. The exact design of the scarf is a surprise, as it's a Mystery Knitalong, and will be revealed as you knit, but it will feature a lace design!

The Knitalong will follow the format of previous Advent Knitalongs: the pattern will be laid out across 24 days (1st - 24th December) and each daily chunk of knitting will be accompanied by a Bible verse following the theme of the weekly reflections.

YARN/NEEDLE REQUIREMENTS

The scarf can be knitted in a variety of yarn weights (a solid colour is best): you'll need either 40 - 45 grams of yarn if using 4ply/fingering weight yarn or Sport weight (and use 3.75 mm needles), or 50 - 55 grams of yarn if using DK weight yarn (and use 4 mm needles). The gauge will vary depending on which yarn weight you use but as long as you use a more generous needle size than you would normally for your chosen yarn then the lace motifs should show up well and the fabric should drape beautifully once blocked.

The scarf reaches a maximum of 33 stitches across, so short needles will be fine!

Additionally, knitters will find 2 stitch markers useful for keeping their place in the pattern (these needn't be anything fancy; small loops of scrap yarn or tiny loom bands will do just as well as shop bought stitch markers) and also a removable marker/progress keeper to attach to the front of the knitting later on, as the front and back of the work will look very similar and this will help to keep track of which side you're on!

LIFELINES

As the scarf pattern contains a fair few lace stitches, less experienced knitters might want to think about using lifelines. These are short lengths of yarn or thread (or some people like to use dental floss!) which are woven through the stitches with a sewing/darning needle at regular intervals so that if stitches are irretrievably dropped or obvious mistakes are made which can't be fixed satisfactorily, the knitting can be undone back to the lifeline and restarted from that point. There are plenty of tutorials available on YouTube and they are quick and easy to insert/use and can save hours of potentially lost knitting!

STITCH KEY

K = knit
pm = place a stitch marker
sm = slip the marker from left needle to right needle
rm = remove marker
YFsl1 = yarn forward, slip one, i.e. bring the yarn to the front of the work and slip the final stitch purl-wise
YO = yarn over
K2tog= knit the next two stitches together
SSK = slip the next two stitches individually knit-wise, then knit them together through the back loop.

CDD= central double decrease, i.e. slip the next two stitches individually knit-wise, then knit the next stitch and pass the 2 previously slipped stitches over the end of the right needle.

RLI = right lifted increase*: with the right needle, lift the horizontal bump of the stitch immediately below the first stitch on the left needle and knit it through the back loop.

LLI = left lifted increase*: with the left needle, lift the horizontal bump of the stitch two rows below the first stitch on the right needle and knit it through the back loop.

* if preferred, knitters may choose to use an alternative increase method. Some of the test knitters preferred to pick up the bar between the stitches and knit into that to create the extra stitch each time. Or if you have used another method in the past (e.g. Kfb/Kbf) then feel free to use that (these are all demonstrated on YouTube). The garter stitch-style fabric of the scarf is quite forgiving, and the increases won't be easily seen, so choose whichever method you find most straightforward.

MODIFICATIONS

There are a few ways that the scarf can be modified. Knitters who are new to lace knitting can make the following substitutions if it makes life easier!

- at the end of each row the pattern requires a YFsl1 (see stitch key). This is just to provide a neater edge to the scarf but is not essential; knitters may prefer simply to knit the last stitch of each row instead.
- in the second half of the pattern there are a few CDD stitches (which decrease 3 stitches to 1 stitch). If preferred, knitters can choose to knit those 3 stitches together (K3tog).

To vary the length of the finished scarf, knitters might want to consider the following:

If knitted as per the pattern exactly, the scarf will measure approximately 75 - 90 cm in length once blocked (see blocking instructions below). If knitters are running short of time or yarn, they may choose to omit rows 121 - 136 and 201 - 216, which will reduce the scarf by about 8 - 10 cm.

Alternatively, if knitters would like a longer scarf, rows 121 - 136 and 201 - 216 can be repeated one or more times, but more yarn will be needed!

REFLECTIONS AND PATTERN

For many of us in the Northern part of the world, there is always the hope that it might snow at Christmas time and we will have a 'White Christmas'. And Christmas cards with snowy themes abound. Often this remains a dream and when it does happen it can be a mixed blessing – causing treacherous conditions outdoors and disrupting travel to loved ones. But the idealised dream remains. This year we will use the theme of snow to take us through our Advent Knitalong and it will remind us of some of the traditional Advent themes: Hope, Peace, Joy and Love.

Week 1 - Hope



Snow comes in winter when lots of plants have lost their leaves and died down. Many animals are hibernating and many birds have flown to warmer places. The days are short and the nights are long. Through all of this dreariness, we look forward

to the renewal we know will come in spring.

As Christians we hold onto the hope that God can also continually renew us. In times of sadness, stagnation or decay we are reassured that this is not the end, but that God can do something new in and for us.

And so for this first week we are accompanied by Bible verses that help us reflect on the hope of God's renewal.

Isaiah 43:18-19

Do not remember the former things,
or consider the things of old.
I am about to do a new thing;
now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?
I will make a way in the wilderness
and rivers in the desert.

PATTERN

Cast on 5 stitches, fairly loosely. (*NB odd numbered rows will be the front/right side of the work; even numbered rows will be the back/wrong side.*)

Set up row: K5.

At this point you might like to add a removable marker to the front of your knitting, as back and front of the work look similar; this will help keep track

of whether you're on the right or wrong side of the project! You can move the marker up the knitting as you go, keeping it on the right side of the work so it is clearly visible as you start each row.



Cast off all stitches loosely and block as follows:

FINISHING/BLOCKING

Cast off all stitches loosely and wet block as follows: soak the scarf for half an hour or so in lukewarm water (a small amount of wool wash can be added if you like) and then gently squeeze out the excess water. Lay the scarf out to dry on a towel or blocking mat, stretching the fabric out to open up the lace stitches and use blocking pins to secure if you have any.

Leave to dry fully before unpinning; sew/weave in loose ends.
